The matrix measures whether a student needs the teacher time of 1, 2, 3, or 4 average students. This allows schools to divide classes so teachers have equitable workloads even though the number of students in the room may vary. It takes approximately 2 hours to use the matrix on 450 students. This tool must be used for ALL students in a classroom in order to be effective and includes instructions for use. It is included in the **Toolkit** (above). \$500 each.

A Plan for Educating All Kids is designed to help organize the task of moving a school district to inclusive practices. It identifies the stakeholder groups that must be included and concerns that need to be addressed with each one. \$100 each.
